SUMMARY OF EXAM MODE

Attending students

Mark is made of battle report + battle performance + 2 questions (choose 1)

Question outline:

- context, introduction (makes you go back to what we were talking in class)
- then question: explain a concept or express an idea or whatever is asked
- **Don't answer to the context (don't rephrase the context.... answer the question!)**

Exam question: give your textual answer, one and a half page in 2 hours: expose what you learnt, not only information retrieval; you can use own examples to show that you understood concepts.

Non attending

Mark is made of case study + 2 questions (5 points each, short) + optional oral exam (+5 points)

What are the topics of the case studies?

Predefined topics are based on battles, or you can send your idea (topic that you would like to deal with, but do that well in time and wait for approval).
